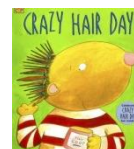

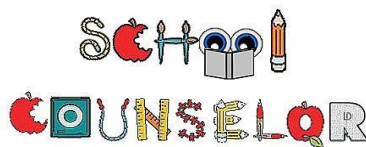


Athletic Department Volunteer Opportunities
